# HAZARDOUS TREE REMOVAL PROGRAM



What type of tree qualifies for this program?

Trees that...

- Are dead, dying, or diseased
- Pose a threat to City of Ocala facilities
- Have structural defects
- Have a poor root system or uprooting
- Have a 50% chance of striking a primary electric distribution line
- Have unrestricted access for limb removal
